



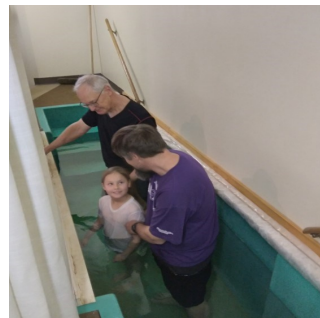
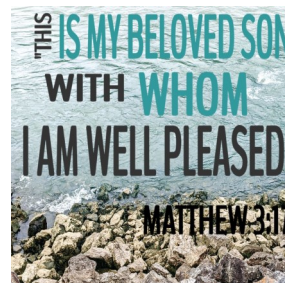

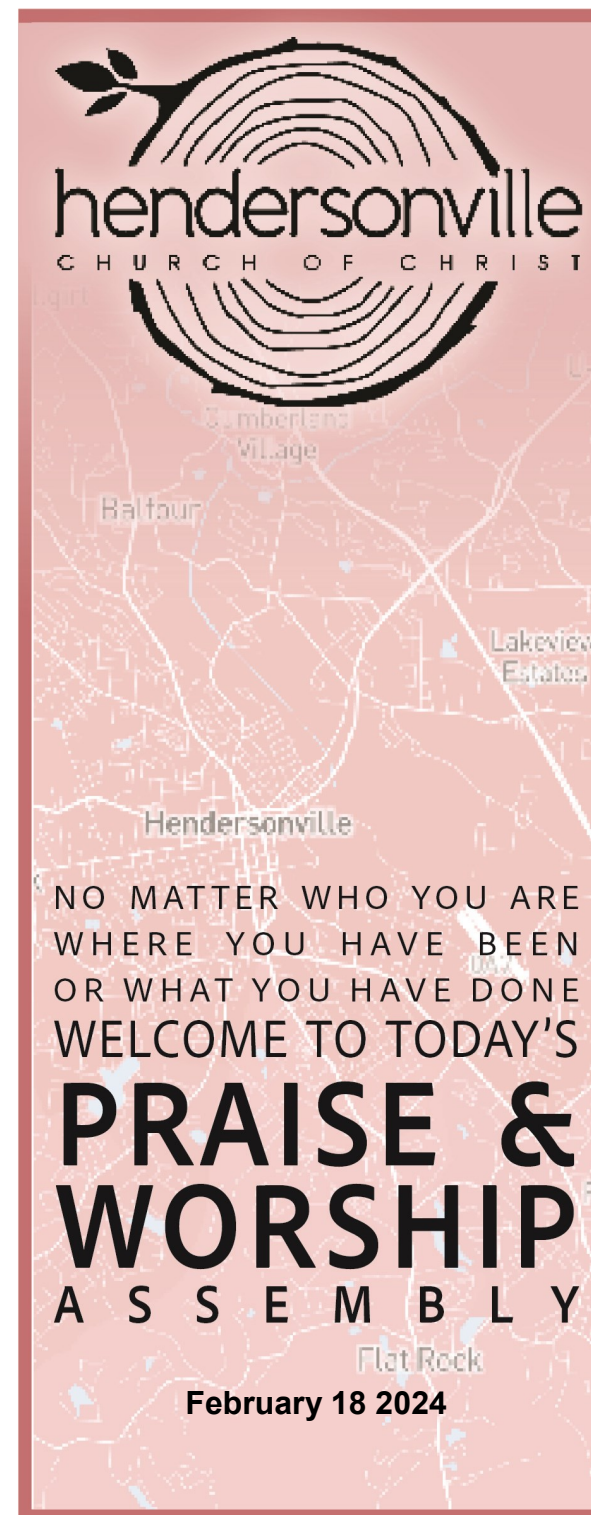

2 Corinthians 2 speaks of the church being “the aroma of Christ” in the world. What does that look like in our assemblies?

Let’s think for a minute about some of the things we might be bringing with us into our assemblies— for one, a natural piece of luggage may likely be whatever is pressing, urgent matters we might be experiencing. Frequent issues might be work issues, finances, health problems or strains and disappointments in some of our relationships. It’s natural to have these concerns. Some of these issues we may have created or contributed to, or they might have come to us through no fault of our own. Still, they seem to demand our attention.

It’s no wonder, why we hear so often in an opening prayer, the request of the Lord to help us “clear our minds and thoughts of the things of this world”. And that’s proper.

What then should be our focus as we come to our assemblies. One thing nearly everyone would mention is “worship to God”. That is certainly true. As has been correctly stated, we should learn how to be more worshipful, because that’s a central aspect we find in most descriptions of heaven and the throne of God. We have a great God who should be worshipped!

Another aspect of our assemblies should be how we experience a common love which emanates from God and flows to one another. Hebrews 10:24-25 stresses being together to “encourage one another unto love and good works”. What’s that saying? Notice one another. Be intentional. I should come to the assembly with two things in mind—Worshipping God, and Encouraging those around me. “The aroma of Christ” should be noticeable all over the room in greetings, hugs, smiles, handshakes, thoughtful conversations—all the things a close, loving family experiences.

And what about our guests? Well, we get one chance to make a first impression. What will they think about us? “Not very friendly, no one spoke to me”, or, “That was a really welcoming church”. How many of us will make the intentional effort to greet a guest, give them a welcome, trade names, shake a hand, or invite them back? We used to sing a song, “And they’ll know we are Christians by our love, by our love...”. Do we feel that from each other? Do our guests experience that? Someone might say, “I’m just not outgoing”. That may be true, but everyone can smile and say, “hello”. Right? Doesn’t it boil down to whether we really want to make the effort, or not.

Let’s remember that our assemblies are not a checklist item, but a specific opportunity to worship, learn, be encouraged, and to encourage—to be the aroma of Christ.
