



Does it ever seem to you that paying attention to God is a difficult thing to do? Life moves so fast, and we have so many things demanding our time. Each day comes with demands and pressures, things that claim to be of the highest priority. We live in an entertainment-saturated world, where we never have to be bored, and so many interesting things are provided for us. For many of us, politics is enthralling, and for others, celebrity gossip or current events (that actually have very little effect on our lives) hold our attention.

All the while, God is there. The majestic Creator of the universe, the most excellent person you have ever met, a true international celebrity who knows our names - he's right there waiting for us to pay attention to him.

C.S. Lewis once said, "God is not proud. He will have us even though we have demonstrated that we prefer almost anything else to him." What he meant is that we'd much rather have our minds distracted or entertained than become attentive to God.

The good news is that while we are not always all that good at paying attention to him, the relationship is not entirely up to us. It's true that we do have veto power. If we decide to reject him, then he will not force himself on us. But if we are interested in friendship with God, he will lavish love, affection, and attention on us.

What Jesus has promised is that if we put effort into our spiritual lives, it will be rewarded. And the reward that God has in mind is nothing less than shocking: he will come and make his home with us! Wouldn't it be enough if he just helped us to escape from the evil and sin that is killing us? Wouldn't it be enough if he healed our hearts of their sorrows and anxiety and cared for our bodies?

Apparently, God does not think that is enough. What God wants is to share with us the loving relationship that is happening between Father, Son, and Spirit - the way the three members of the Trinity care for about one another is what he wants to give to us.

So he comes to live with us and within us. He makes his home with us, meaning that he is present with us and paying attention to us. He is willing to pour energy and resources into this relationship, because it is a far higher priority to him than it often is to us.

The sad, normal condition of the human sinner is to be both rebellious toward God and inattentive to him. It is God's great love for us that eventually draws us to him. Him being present with us is what eventually captures our minds and hearts.

And once we do begin to notice him, we realize that there really isn't anything that is as fascinating as God. When we are with him, there is delight and peace that are far greater experiences than the mere distraction or frivolity offered by our world. It can be hard to pay attention to him, but it is entirely worth the effort.
